Asynchronous

- Provide an asynchronous lesson at the time the class begins on Google Classroom
- Provide availability at an agreed upon time with remote student(s) during the same or following day

Safety

- Student desks are placed 6' apart in the classrooms. When students enter the classroom they will pick up a paper desk matt that will stay on the desk until the end of the period and then will be thrown into a recycling bin at the end of the period.
- Students will be expected to follow the signage posted throughout the building. i.e. directional arrows in hallways, one person using the restroom at a time.
- Water Fountains bubblers will be shut off but bottle fills will be operational.
- Students will not be assigned hall lockers and gym locker rooms will not be used for PE classes.

Safety Cont.

- Information on masks
 - Must be worn at all times with the following exceptions
 - While seated in a the cafeteria and eating breakfast or lunch
 - During mask breaks while seated in the classroom at teachers direction
 - Masks can be disposable
 - Can be reusable cloth type
 - No gaiters permitted
 - No bandanas
 - No scarves
 - Must comply with our Code of Conduct-no markings on mask that would disrupt the learning environment
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the building

Safety Cont.

- Arrival / Dismissal (students will not be permitted to enter the building until 7 am)
 - Student walkers and students being dropped off will enter the building through the auditorium entrance. Students taking a bus will enter through the main entrance.
- All students will be dismissed at 2:04 PM and must leave the building.
- No in-person clubs, however, a list of online club opportunities will be available.
- Sports may begin in mid-Sept

Nurse Mrs. G- Health & Safety Protocols/Screening

- Morning Screenings
 - Screenings should be done prior to arriving at school through the app
 - Failure to do so will result in not being able to come into the building
- Health Office Procedures
 - Teachers will call Health Office stating why student is coming
 - If student has any of the symptoms of Covid-19 including
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Body Aches
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Vomiting or Diarrhea
 - Sore Throat
 - Nasal Congestion
 - Headache
 - Been exposed to someone who has Covid-19 in the last 14 days
 - Has tested positive for Covid-19 but has not completed requirements for return to school
 - Students will be sent home immediately.

Health & Safety Protocols/Screening

- There is no resting in the health office
- There is no eating in the health office
- Temperatures will be taken prior to entering the health office
- Students must go to class then have a teacher call them to send to the health office. NO stopping between classes.
- **What happens if your student gets sent home sick?**
 - Nurse will notify parents to pick up student within 30 minutes
 - Student will wait in the isolation room in the health office
 - Students will be escorted out of the health office to the car. Parents will not come in.
- **What is required for you student to return to school after being sick?**
 - Clearance note from a health care provider stating they are cleared to return to school
 - Negative Covid-19 test with documentation provided to the health office
 - No fever for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication
 - Symptom free for 3 days
 - If a student is Positive for Covid-19 they will need all of the above plus a “Release from Isolation” letter from the Dutchess County Department of Behavioral and Community Health

Health & Safety Protocols/Screening

- Possible exposures at home or at school
 - If the student is exposed to someone outside of school
 - Quarantine for 14 days even if they have a negative Covid-19 test
 - If the student begins to have symptoms, then a Covid-19 test must be taken
 - If the test is Positive contact school nurse immediately and follow above instructions
 - If the health office is notified of a positive case in the school
 - we will contact the Department of Behavioral and Community Health for guidelines
 - School will be closed for “at a minimum of one day in order to clean and begin contact tracing”
 - Students will be notified by School Messenger
- Physicals and Immunizations
 - 9th and 11th grades still need physicals
 - Immunizations remain as required with NO exceptions
- Medications in School
 - Inhalers with or without spacers are to be used in school
 - Nebulizer medication will only be used if necessary
 - Healthcare Provider order will need to be updated for this school year.

Grading

- We will follow the **Traditional Numerical Grading** system
 - 0-100 on assignments
 - 50 - 100 on Quarter 1 Grades, then 0-100 Quarters 2-4
- **Final Averages**
 - Average of 4 Quarter Grades
 - If Regents/Finals are given, we will determine how we will factor them into final averages at the beginning of Quarter 4
- **Classwork/Homework assignments**
 - Minimum of one graded assignment per week
- **Testing**
 - Testing will predominantly be done on M, Thurs, F (remote days)
 - Equity and parity with remote and in-school students since tests are done remotely

Grading

- **Participation will be a factor in all course grades**
 - Students are expected to log on or arrive (in person) log in(remote) on time for each class.
 - Students are expected to leave their cameras on during instruction and assessments.
- **Cheating Concerns**
 - Remote testing is inherently less secure
 - Your support and reiteration to your child to keep tests secure & valid is important
 - Tests may focus more on written response instead of multiple choice
 - Students' Google Meet cameras must be on during tests and quizzes

Breakfast & Lunch

- Dining Hall is set up with individual student desks 6' apart (no tables).
- Breakfast will be available to students
- Students will be permitted to remove their masks while seated and eating.
- Safety Protocols
 - Meals are individually wrapped
 - Desks will be cleaned between lunch blocks
 - Meal containers and utensils are disposable

Attendance

- Attending all classes (in-person and remotely) is required and attendance is taken during every class (instructional) period.
 - Cameras must be on for attendance; remainder of period follow teacher's direction
- An attendance email will go out to all parents at the end of the day, approximately 2:45 pm (stating an overall : absence) encouraging you to check Parent Portal for absences. Please review the portal to ensure your child is attending every class daily.

PE Classes

- In-person PE Classes like other odd/even classes (Math/Science Labs, Computer Studies, Study Skills, Study Hall) will be seen in-person every other week
- Locker rooms will not be used
- Any activity will be low risk, socially distant, and mask friendly/break and outdoors whenever possible.
- Remote students will be provide instruction/directions from teacher
