Dear Student and Parent/Guardian:

I hope you had a great summer. Although things will continue to look different for the coming school year, I am truly excited to work with you as your High School Principal. I am looking forward to making this year as enjoyable and productive as possible.

Start of School Year

The school year will begin on Thursday, September 10, 2020. Our District will post a transportation schedule on our website for students who ride buses. Walkers should plan to arrive by 7:25 A.M. and Period 1/HR will begin promptly at 7:28 A.M. During Period 1/HR your teacher will review important school rules and course procedures and expectations.

On September 10th, all students will begin remote instruction. On September 15th (last names A-K) and 16th (last names L-Z), we will hold a 9th grade orientation where only 9th grade students will be in the building following a regular day schedule (all other students will follow a regular day schedule, remotely). I will meet with all 9th grade students during their English classes to review our Code of Conduct and updated building procedures due to the Covid-19 Pandemic.

On September 22nd our hybrid schedule (in-school) will begin. In-school students will on September 22nd, last names A-K and September 23rd last names L-Z, receive forms to be signed by the student and parent/guardian regarding Code of Conduct/Handbook and cell phone procedures during their Period 1/HR. Fully remote students can print a copy of these forms using the provided hyperlink. All forms should be returned to the students' Period 1/HR teachers on either September 29th or 30th. Fully remote students can either return the forms to the main office or mail them in Attention Geri Vasely.
